## **Eminent Speaker at the General Assembly**

The central keynote speaker of the General Assembly is **Mr Rami Khouri**, an internationally renowned author, journalist and lecturer. Of Palestinian-Jordanian origin, he is a US citizen with residence in Beirut, Amman and Nazareth. In 2006, Mr Khouri received the Pax Christi International Peace Award for his efforts to bring peace and reconciliation to the Middle East.

Mr Khouri is Director of the Issam Fares Institute\* as well as Editor-at-large of the Beirut-based Daily Star newspaper, published throughout the Middle East with the International Herald Tribune.

He is author of A View from the Arab World, an internationally syndicated political column. His work has been published in leading international publications, including the Financial Times, the Boston Globe and the Washington Post.

Mr Khouri lectures in media and politics at the University of Chicago and is a senior fellow at the JFK School of Government at Harvard University. He was a visiting scholar at Stanford University in 2006.
